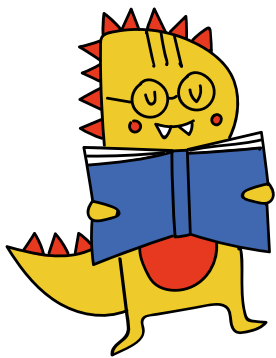


HOMework

Homework progresses in line with these principles from EYFS to Year 6, with some increases in expectations to help to prepare the children for their transition to high school.



ENGLISH reading

Please listen to your child read their allocated phonics book:

3-5 TIMES PER WEEK
for 10 MINS EACH SESSION

Also share a range of other books at home with your child, including their school library book.



ENGLISH phonics

3 x 5 MINUTES PER WEEK PHONICS FOLDER

A selection of previously taught sounds, words and captions/sentences for your child to decode and read independently. Please date and sign the sheet each time you have practised the sounds and leave the sheets in the folder.
